

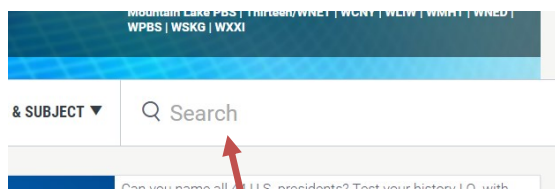
# PBS Learning Media

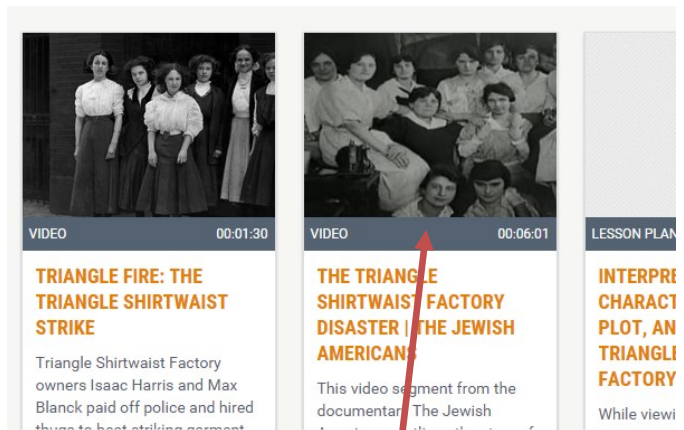


- Free database of video clips, interactive websites, images, primary sources, lesson plans, and more - all from PBS

- Focuses more on short video clips than full length documentaries

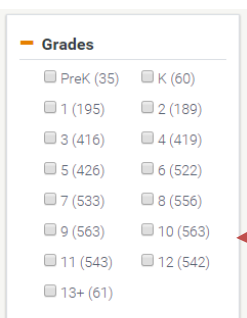
## How to search for media:

Click on your result to view or download




Use the sidebar to refine your search by grade, subject, type, and more.


