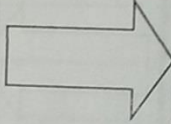

- The people look dirty

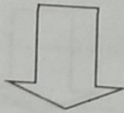


Inferences:

This picture taught me that people lived in horrible environments because they slept on hardwood floors, they didn't take baths, and there was more than 10 people living in one room.

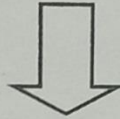

Prior Knowledge and New Understandings

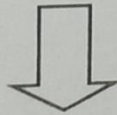
I knew...
